I want to again thank you for your willingness to support the Navy SEAL Museum San Diego as a Docent or Volunteer! You participation will be critical in fulfilling our mission of preserving the culture and history of Naval Special Warfare to educate and inspire.

Updates:

We continue to make great progress and move closer to opening in the Summer of 2025 in our downtown Showcase facility. Construction is ongoing and our SDV (Swimmer Delivery Vehicle) is ready to hang on the 2nd deck ceiling in December. New walls, sheetrock and paint have rapidly been installed since our last update.





Additionally, after months of design and hard work, we have installed the display cases on the Trolley Platform directly behind the Showcase. These cases will be seen daily by thousands of people passing through the Trolley Station.

We continue to focus on registering quality volunteers like yourselves for our planned opening in Summer 2025. Exact opening date still is to be determined as the build-out and exhibits are constructed.

Who makes a good Docent?


